FUN WAYS TO WRITE



- >> In shaving cream
- >> In salt spread over a baking sheet
- >> In finger paint
- >> With a highlighter
- >> In Play Doh with a toothpick

POPSICLE STICKS!



- >> Write letters or sight words on popsicle sticks and pull them from a cup.
- >> Write an "e" on a popsicle stick to make a magic wand that turns short vowels into long vowels.

FOCUS ON SOUNDS



- >> Pick out the beginning, middle, and ending sounds in words.
- >> Listen for the ending sound in a word and think of a word that begins with that sound. Keep going!

MOVE, MOVE, MOVE!



- >> Write letters or words on paper and read while hopping on them.
- >> Count the sounds in words and try to toss a bean bag in a basket for each sound.

LETTER COOKIES



- >> Spell words with letter cookies for a fun activity with a sweet reward at the end.

CLASSIC GAMES WITH SIGHT WORDS



- >> Tic Tac Toe: each player picks a sight word and writes that word instead of X or O on the squares.
- >> Bingo: write out Bingo cards with letters, sight words, or words that use a certain sound or concept.
